

ROCKY COMITO 5TH ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS

1. You, the Applicant must be a member in good standing of Autotruck Financial Credit Union to apply.

2. The maximum scholarship for each student selected for the current school year will be \$1,000.00. Only those individuals who are registered or will be registering as a full-time student at an Accredited College/University need apply. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the Accredited College/University and is to be used for tuition and books only.

3. Scholarship money received may be considered taxable income under the current IRS guidelines.

Submit the following information:

1. Completed Application.

2. Official Transcript with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 including SAT/ACT test results. (Must be initialed by a Counselor or someone within the Registrar's Office.)

3. A signed Letter of Recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, college professor or administrator, community or church leader or any non family member.

4. Copy of the Acceptance Letter from the Accredited College/University.

5. List of Academic Achievements.

6. List of all Extracurricular Activities such as school activities.

7. List of Community Involvement such as organizations, church and volunteer work. Provide the name of the organization, the type of work and the time involved.

8. Essay of 500-550 typed words* answering the following question:

How important is managing money and financial security to you? Do you have a monthly budget? What advice would you give someone who wants to build credit, buy a car, save for the future, or even buy a home?

9. List Tuition Cost and provide name and amount of any Financial Assistance you will be receiving.

All Scholarship entries must have the completed application and all required documentation to Autotruck Financial Credit Union postmarked no later than July 1, 2024.
